Please note that both high school girls' races will be 5000 meters.

We will be scoring the varsity races as small and large school divisions. All runners will start together and use the same finish line, as we will be using chip timing. Division assignments will be based on 2015-16 enrollments, unless otherwise requested.

<u>Individual Awards:</u> Varsity-medals top 10 runners in each division, ribbons 11-20 in each division. JV-ribbons top 15 combined divisions. Middle school—ribbons top 15.

<u>Team Awards:</u> Plaque and medals 1st place boys' and girls' team in each division. Plaque to second place team each division.

<u>Course</u>: Course maps will be available on race day. The course is a combination of open prairie and woods with a few asphalt crossings. Course markings will be at 800 meters, 1000 meters, 1600 meters, 2000 meters, 3000 meters, 3200 meters, and 4000 meters.

<u>Scoring:</u> Scoring the meet will be White River Sports Timing. They will have race packets and single-use timers for pick-up when you arrive. They will also have results available after the last race. Please register with White River Sports on their website at www.itiming.com by Sunday, Sept. 11, 2016.
