Check-In:

Meet day information and timing devices will be available for pick-up at the finish line.

Emergency Procedures:

- 1. There will be a licensed athletic trainer on hand near the finish line
- 2. There will be a trail vehicle for both races
- 3. In case of severe weather, the fieldhouse will be available for shelter
- 4. Nearest AED is located next to the Fieldhouse bathrooms.

Concessions & Event T-Shirts:

Will be located just inside the doors of the fieldhouse. Pre-Ordered t-shirts can be picked up at the concession stand for distribution by coaches.

Restricted Areas:

Start & Finish line areas are the only restricted areas on the course. Be sure to remind your athletes that they must remain in uniform in these areas.

Tent Area:

The area just outside the fieldhouse, between the pool and tennis courts will be designated for team camp areas. The fieldhouse will also be available for team camps in the event of poor weather.

Buses:

Buses can drop off and pick-up near the end of the south parking lot by the team tent area. But we would ask them to park in either the north or east lots to allow for more spectator parking in the south lot.

Bathrooms:

There will be bathrooms open in the pool/fieldhouse area. There will be no locker rooms available. Please have your athletes come prepared to run. There will also be port-a-potties available in the team camp area, as well as near the starting line (for athletes only)

Pets:

Please remind your fans that pets are not allowed at WIAA events and should be kept at home. We must do everything to make sure our athletes have a safe environment to compete.

Team Entry Fee:

All participating schools are to pay a \$25 per gender entry fee. Incomplete teams pay \$5 per athlete.

Spectator Entry Fee:

We will have an entrance fee of \$5 per person (under 5 free) at the gate near the team tent area. Please let your fans know of this entry fee in advance.
