Prom 1. The guest is less than 21 years of age; and, 2. The guest is currently attending high school or is a high school graduate and is currently attending a post-secondary institution or is currently employed. Verification from the employer or post-secondary institution must accompany the guest verification form. Fall Ball Guest must currently be enrolled in high school.
