Game reports will be verified by the scorer, signed by the official and a copy will be given to each team.**
2. "Home" team, second team listed, will wear dark, occupy the North bench, and defend the North goal to start, provide the game ball, official game scoresheet and kick off.
3. Officials should check in at the brown shed in center of the four fields to sign their payment vouchers and to report scores/issues.
4. There will be a tab running at the concession stand all day for officials. Please hydrate and eat as needed during the day.
