Attendance Requirement:		
Accordance Requirements		
Students must be in attendance a minimum of 90% of the school days to attend the Fall Ball or Prom. For Fall Ball, the attendance rate will be calculated from September 3 through October 4. For Prom, attendance will be calculated from September 3 through February 26.		
The following reasons for being absent will <u>not</u> be factored into the 90% attendance rate:

Guests are welcome at the Prom and Fall Ball with the following stipulations:		
Fall Ball		
Guest must currently be enrolled in high school. (must provide verification form with signature from the principal)		
The Fall Ball is open to students in grades 9 through 12.		
<u>Prom</u>		
The guest must be less than 21 years of age.		
The guest must currently be:		
1. attending high school or		
2.is a high school graduate and is currently attending a post-secondary institution (must provide verification form with signature from the post-secondary institution)		
3.or is currently employed (must provide verification form with signature from the employer)		
The Prom is open to students in grades 11 and 12. A Superior High School student in grade 11 or 12 may bring a guest who is in grade 10. The Prom is not open to 9 th grade students.
