

- 2021 Federal Tax Return and W2's
- 2021 Untaxed Income Records (Child Support, Veterans non-education benefits etc.)
- Info. On savings, investments, business assets (incl. farm)
- Drivers License, Cell phone, Social Security number
- Alien registration card or permanent resident card (if not a U.S. citizen)
- Parents D.O.B.
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce, or separation
- FSA ID. To create a FSA ID, please visit studentaid.gov. Every student and at least one parent, if the student is considered a dependent, needs a FSA ID
