



- · 2021 Untaxed Income Records (Child Support, Veterans non-education benefits etc.)
- · Info. On savings, investments, business assets (incl. farm)
- · Drivers License, Cell phone, Social Security number
- · Alien registration card or permanent resident card (if not a U.S. citizen)
- · Parents D.O.B.
- · Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce, or separation
- · FSA ID. To create a FSA ID, please visit <u>studentaid.gov</u>. Every student and at least one parent, if the student is considered a dependent, needs a FSA ID

Interested in Rotary? Stop by the Guidance Office and pick up an application.


